

BERGHOLZ COMMUNITY FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP . APPLICATION GUIDELINES

1. Scholarships will be awarded in the following categories:

- 2022 Edison High School and Edison JVS graduates
- 2022 private/home school graduates who live in the Edison Local School District
- Non-traditional students-to be eligible, these applicants should be past graduates of Edison High School or the ELSD's consolidated high schools who are seeking a first time associate or undergraduate degree or technical training.
- Any high school graduate that resides within the Edison School District.
- Each applicant must submit a complete application package. Incomplete application packages will not be considered, **please complete all 5 pages.**
- The application deadline is Friday, April 8, 2022. Send completed applications to:

2. First consideration for the scholarship will be given to ELSD students who live within the Bergholz and Springfield Township area. Financial need and other scholarships the student is slated to receive will be taken into consideration in awarding this scholarship.

3. Scholarships are awarded for tuition at any accredited college or university for a program leading to an associate or undergraduate degree or an accredited post high school program for technical training. If other grant/scholarship money is available to the student, it must be exhausted prior to use of the Bergholz Community Foundation Scholarship. Example: Students receiving a full Pell Grant are not eligible for this scholarship.

4. The scholarship requires full-time attendance status – 12 credit hours or a minimum part-time attendance status – 6 credit hours for a partial scholarship consideration.

5. The number and amount of the scholarships awarded varies each year based on the annual statement of the treasurer concerning the income available for scholarship awards.

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6. The Scholarships are a one-time award.

7. Payment of scholarships awarded for tuition will be made directly to the college according to the institution's payment deadlines. The student must notify the Bergholz Community Foundation treasurer, Terri McConaughy (740-768-2494) at least 2 weeks in advance of any change regarding the scholarship payment.

8. Scholarships awarded must be used during the 2022-2023 school year or forfeited unless deferred to a later date due to a grant such as the Eastern Gateway Community College Horizon Grant. Scholarships may be deferred for no longer than 3 years.

Lack of use during the stated time period will result in forfeiture of the scholarship. Forfeited scholarship funds will be redistributed to other applicants.
